





#### LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK

Just two hours drive from Nairobi, Lake Nakuru is among Kenya's finest national parks. Though famous for the pink flamingoes lining the shores of the lake and the hundreds of preening white pelicans, the small park (only 180 sq km) is home to the black and white rhino, the tree-climbing lions, leopard, large herds of buffaloes and the rare Rothschild's giraffes as well as many other animals and birds.

wildlife free to roam between Kenya and Tanzania in search of food.




